

PREPARATION FOR BEDBUG TREATMENTS:

REMOVE ALL BEDDING - Remove all bedding, covers, sheets, pillows, etc. Place in large plastic trash bag to carry out to the laundry room for washing. Placing items in bags eliminates the possibility of dropping bedbugs through out the house.

DISASSEMBLE BED - Disassemble bed, remove mattress and box spring, stand both items against the closest wall. Headboard and foot board need to be removed from the side rails. You may leave these item in place lying on the floor.

CLOTHING - Closets must be emptied completely; likewise dressers and night stands. All clothing must be bagged and taken to the laundry area for wash.

PERSONAL ITEMS - personal items need to be placed in a box and removed from the room

TREATMENT - Upon arrival we will be prepared to start our treatment; occupants are not allowed in the rooms and areas that will be treated. Thoroughness is essential and reliant upon the detailed preparation requested. We will be treating every crack, crevice and cranny that could be used by bedbugs as a hiding place. These areas will be injected with a residual pesticide, Baseboards, closets, furniture, and bed framing will all be treated. After the crack and crevice treatment we will be fogging with a ULV to flush out the bedbugs. This treatment requires evacuation and a re-entry period of 4 hours from completion.
